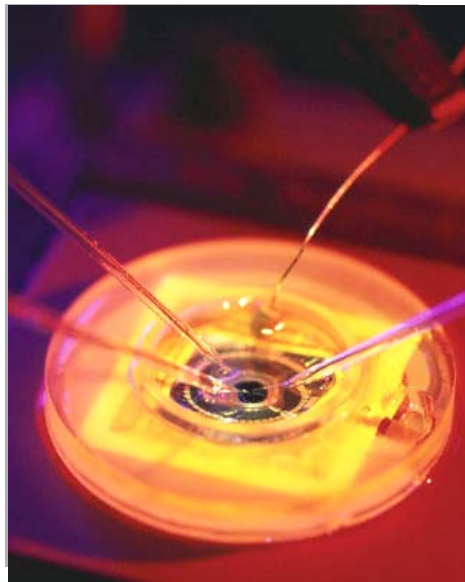


GOAL AND OBJECTIVES

The goals of this meeting are to update General Surgeons and other learners on scientific advances in the field of General Surgery and updates on clinical issues of interest to the practising surgeon.

Attendees will be updated on pertinent issues in paediatric surgery, breast reconstructive surgery, parathyroid surgery and anal fistulae. Current research in diabetes mellitus will be presented. The management of complex abdominal wall herniation will be discussed in detail, appraising attendees of current techniques and best prosthetic materials. Surgeons will have an opportunity to gain experience with transanal endoscopic microsurgical techniques and hand assisted laparoscopic colectomy.
